## ORDER EXTENDING THE STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Hurricane Helene caused substantial damage to public buildings, public streets and roads, public drainage systems, commercial and residential buildings, and constitutes an ongoing Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida, in Executive Order 24-208 and Executive Order 24-209, found that a state of emergency exists within specified Counties within the State of Florida, including Pinellas County, and in coordination with ongoing emergency actions by the state and federal governments, the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners (Board) passed Resolution 24-68 declaring a state of local emergency in Pinellas County (Resolution); and

**WHEREAS**, in order to fully and effectively continue the various response and recovery efforts needed due to the scope and scale of the destruction in Pinellas County, and to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the community, continuing the state of local emergency is necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 252.38(3)(a)5, Florida Statutes, provides authority for a political subdivision such as Pinellas County to exercise emergency powers; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to §252.38(1), Florida Statutes, and Pinellas County Charter section 2.04 (k), the County has jurisdictional authority over the entire county for emergency management purposes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DECLARED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, this 1st day of October 2024:
