Description & Comments

This item requests authorization to execute six (6) Letters of Agreement with Medicaid Managed Care Organizations as the next step to receive funding from the Medicaid Public Emergency Medical Transportation Intergovernmental Transfer Program (PEMT IGT). This program supplements public entities with unreimbursed fees associated with emergency ambulance transportation services for Medicaid recipients enrolled in Medicaid Managed Medical Assistance (MMA) Plans. Previous steps within this process were documented and approved through Granicus items 19-1607A and 19-2371A.

Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services has been invoiced for the IGT program in the amount of \$1,779,218.94 and is projected to receive an allocation in the amount of \$4,617,749.65; which results in a net revenue of \$2,838,530.71.

This net revenue amount has been included in the FY20 Estimates as part of the FY21 Budget development process.
