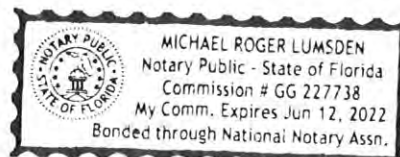

Dear Neighbor,


I am Erin Gregory and I live at 8990 131st St, Seminole. We have lived there since October 2019. We started leasing and bought it in November 2020. We were told before we moved in that the property was zoned for horses. We have 2 children Parker (age 10) and Tanner (age 8) that go to Bauder Elementary school. My daughter has been riding horses since 2017 and when we found a property that was in Bauder Elementary School zone, able to live in immediately, zoned for horses, and in our price range we were beyond excited!! We had big dreams for this property!!

We bought our horse in September 2020. We were obviously not allowed to make any changes to the property while renting, and once we purchased Covid was in full swing and building materials were beyond expensive. We were able to keep our horse at the barn where my daughter rides for free, only paying for his food and care. Unfortunately the property was only leased by our riding club, and was sold. Needless to say we needed to find a new home for our horse. That is when we found out that our property was no longer allowed to have horses living on it. Apparently it has always been zoned an R-2, but because it is over an acre in unincorporated Pinellas County the land use code allowed horses. This changed in June 2021. If our horse would have already been on the property we would have been grandfathered in.

We are now applying for a rezone. This is costing us \$1400 just to submit the application since we were not grandfathered in, and we are not guaranteed approval. I believe the county will notify you once we put our application in and it starts moving through the process. We wanted to reach out with a more personal letter than just a standard form from the county. It has always been my dream to have a property with horses, and now my daughter shares that same dream, and my husband fully supports that dream. We love living in Seminole, and that we are only a half mile from a horse park with miles of trails, while still living close to the beach and family. We want you all to know that we will abide by all codes and have talked with the code enforcement officer who will come and walk us through all of the rules about barn location, manure disposal, and all of those types of things. Some of you may have already noticed that our horse does come to hang out at the house occasionally on the weekend. Some of you may NOT have noticed because he hardly makes a peep and usually spends the day just grazing about the yard.

We hope that if you have any questions you will reach out to us. There will be a hearing open to the public and we are hoping that none of our neighbors will come and object. Again, this is my dream! We have big plans for this property! I want this to be a home that we retire in, that maybe my daughter lives in as an adult and raises her family in! Again, please reach out to us if you have any questions or concerns!!

MY HORSE. Hi! Just putting some feelers out there to see what the neighborhood consensus is. We bought an acre property with the intent to keep our horse on it. We were told that the property was zoned for horses. We found out a few months ago the property was not, in fact, zoned for horses. We can apply to have it rezoned and hope that no one objects. I would like to know if any of my adjacent neighbors would completely object. We live in a horse area. We have an acre of property. We are the only property within a 1 mile radius that is at least 1 acre and not zoned an RR or RE. I have 3 "horse crossing" signs within a half mile of my house AND we are a half mile from the Walsingham Horseman Association. We actually moved our horse to the horse property on 86th Ave & 134th St, so he is in walking distance to our house. He was on our property yesterday and we walked him to the new barn yesterday afternoon. While at my house Pinellas County Sheriff Dept received 4 phone calls about the horse. I would like to know who called and why. If you are on here and reading this please let me know why it bothered you so much. Please give me some feedback, I'd love to know the neighborhoods thoughts and opinions. It has been a lifelong dream for me to have a house where I can keep horses and I really want to make this happen!
