Description & Comments

This item requests Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approval and execution of Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Emergency Watershed Protection (EWP) Program grant agreement. The agreement begins upon execution and ends June 1st, 2028.

This agreement provides \$29,442,604.40 in federal grant funding for channel restoration and stabilization at Joe's Creek, Smith Bayou, South Creek, and Curlew Creek. There is no match required.

Because these channels were impacted by Hurricane Milton, expenditures for stabilization efforts have been and will be captured under Hurricane Milton CIP Projects, project 90019B4, an emergency project. Funding for these projects will be made available from General Fund reserves and eligible costs will be offset with reimbursement through the NRCS grant agreement.

- No match requirement; An amendment to recognize the NRCS grant revenue will be brought forward at a later date.
