Qualification Requirements: The Parks and Conservation Resources Advisory Board acts in an advisory capacity to the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and the county administrator in their power to provide parks, preserves, historical commissions and other recreational and cultural programs.

Ten (10) total members appointed by the BCC. Seven of the members are nominated by each member of the BCC with one-year terms that run concurrently with that of their respective nominating Commissioner. Of the three additional members, one must be a member of and nominated by the County's Youth Advisory Committee, and two must have experience in environmental science and/or policy; the terms of these three additional members are likewise one-year terms that run from August 1st through July 31st.
