Hi! Regarding the new award, I don't think there is anything we can do to make adjustments of the nature you are asking for as that constitutes a "budget amendment" not a correction. I would suggest you go ahead with processing of the award.

On the expenditure of funds from FY 21 for the purchase completed in FY 20, I think as long as the expenditure was completed by September 30, you have the ability to draw down funds during the 90 day window following the end of the FY to in essence pay yourself back. The expenditure would be tracked in your annual FFR for FY 20 which is due 12/31/2020.

Regarding the requested budget updates, we will not be able to do anything with the changes until sometime in January after the start-up of our new grant award system (Next Generation Grants System (NGGS)) which is due to come on-line as of December 11th. I think all of this will depend on the EPA budget process, and whether we have another continuing resolution or an approved budget which will control our next step regarding grant awards.

Please find included herein our proposed FY21 changes to reflect the additional equipment purchases and changes in staff. Unfortunately, the award arrived yesterday which adds an extra rumple to the process. We are requesting the following highlighted corrections to the Award's Object Class Categories to reflect these changes:

- 1. Personnel, Fringe & Indirect dollars will go down slightly with the retirement of four staff, two re-classifications upward, two re-classifications downward and two <u>proposed</u> downward re-classifications.
- 2. Travel Class decreased in FY20 due to Covid, and carryover of those FY20 dollars should travel occur again in FY21.
- 3. Equipment Object Class increased to account for \$40,960 in additional purchases.
- 4. Indirect Cost Increased to 36.03% due to increase in Indirect Rate for FY21.

We seek approval to use the FY21 federal dollars to pay for the \$58,170 FY20 equipment purchased early.

Do we process the award we just received, or can the award be corrected to reflect our FY21 Request as stated and high-lighted below? We are hoping for a correction rather than another amendment.
