## **Qualification Requirements:**

The Pinellas County Educational Facilities Authority assists fully accredited institutions of higher education and educational facilities as defined in Chapter 159, Part II, Florida Statutes, by providing an additional means to finance facilities and structures. The authority issues bonds in order to make loans for the costs of projects, with the institution receiving the loan responsible for repayment and for cost of administration. Bond issues for educational facility financings are projects approved by the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners (BCC). The BCC appoints five members, including one member who must be a trustee, director, officer or employee of an institution of higher education.
