I received word from the State a new signed form is not required to increase the ask for the signal cabinets. Per the grants process, as this is seeking more than the original application it will need to be rerouted through Legistar with the new figures. I have confirmed with OMB that this needs to go back to the Board. I will need Kelli's approval to submit a revised grant request for HMGP traffic cabinets from \$2,625,000 to \$3,988,299. This will adjust our cost share from \$875,000 to \$1,329,433. Given the State Appropriations (\$750k) the balance of the required match is \$579,433.

Is Kelli's approval something you would like to get Tom, or shall I? OMB will accept an email as they will just be revising the original intent to apply.

Good morning

So, the State has shared how their costs were determined for the increased budget as I could not reconcile what we submitted with what they have. [4828-\(295\) Budget \(12-31-25\)-signed COMMENTS](#)

It appears each site has "design, survey, and post design fees" added to the line-item costs. These appear to equate to approximately 13.6%. There were a few minor errors in the State's budget which we will proceed with due to timelines.

Attached is what I would like to resubmit. The request was to add the name of the person from whom the budget came. In the process to ensure alignment, I updated the budget to include the fees and remove the individual contingencies. Our new budget submission will be total project costs of \$5,317,732.00, 75% of which will be a federal request. We are now asking for \$3,988,299 with a \$1,329,433 match. \$750k of which the State has provided appropriations resulting in \$579,433 in match coming from Transportation's budget.

If agreeable, I will submit back to the State and begin processing the Legistar. We will require a new Board approval to cover the increased ask.

Thank you for providing us with the final budget package with the County's comments and concerns. We greatly appreciate the open line of communication Pinellas County has had while we have worked to review this project. After further internal discussion, we have determined that the total project cost listed on the budget that was originally developed is the amount we will be proceeding with. The final budget package was submitted to our Engineering team for their review on 12/31/25. To revise the budget at this point would result in delays in submitting the project to FEMA, and we are on a tight deadline to complete all submittals.

Since the requested revisions total to \$34,636.00, in the future, if it is determined that an increase to the total project cost is necessary following an award, a request can then be submitted to reallocate funds from the contingency. For your awareness, there are \$253,225.00 in contingency funds available within the developed budget for future use. We would like to reiterate that we understand budgets may change during a project's lifecycle, so the current figure is an estimate.

Thank you for reaching out! I can provide some further clarification on the following items:

- **Cost Share Split:** Although the total project cost is over the LMS endorsed amount the project will still be submitted to FEMA as a Tier 1. However, the cost share split will be adjusted to reflect the decreased federal and increased local share amounts instead of the typical 75%/25% ratio. For the above-referenced project the breakdown is \$2,625,000.00 (49.363149553%) for the federal share and \$2,692,732.00 (50.636850447%) for the local share.
- **SFHA:** The SFHA form only needs to be completed by Pinellas County for insurable structures directly receiving HMGP funds that currently exist in a SFHA and will remain within a SFHA at the close out of the project. An insurable structure is defined as a building with two or more outside rigid walls and a fully secured roof, that is affixed to a permanent site. If the cabinets do not meet the criteria, then the SFHA form is not required to be completed.

We would gladly meet to discuss the project further. Based on the times provided, Friday March 6th, 11:00AM-12:00 PM EST works best for us. We will schedule the meeting via Teams shortly.
