### Description & Comments

This Local Agency Emergency Repair Agreement (LAERA) agreement formalizes cooperation between Pinellas County and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) within the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA)'s emergency relief program for repair of the Dunedin Causeway. This program applies to eligible federal aid roadways which sustained damages during a declared disaster event, in this case Hurricane Helene which caused significant damage throughout the County in September 2024.

\*Funding for this project is available via the General Fund Reserve – in particular project 90018C1 for Hurricane Helene related road and bridge repairs – and the estimated amounts for completion of this work were included in the total dollar amounts in Resolution 24-88 which was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024. This repair has been completed and will be reimbursed at a 100% federal cost share with no County match required.
