**Date/Time/Comments:** 8/1/19 Approval and execution of the agreement with Jon R. Thogmartin, M.D., P.A., District Six Medical Examiner (Medical Examiner) for professional services related to the Medical Examiner's Office and Pinellas County Forensic Laboratory. This is an annual agreement. Reviewed prior agreement 18-1118A, and there are three options for renewal through FY2023 if approved. No changes noted over prior agreement. Limits shown are the same as expiring except Auto Liability was removed based on new metrics and the advisement by Daisy Rodriguez that the Medical Examiner generally performs his duties in the office. **08/06/2019 Spoke to Megan Burg in M.E. office. Medical examiner does have several vehicles that are used for transport to and from investigations and to crematory. Auto requirements added back in to requirements.**

**NOTES:** This agreement provides funding for Medical Examiner operations and Pinellas County Forensic Laboratory services in accordance with Chapter 406, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 11G, Florida Administrative Code. The Medical Examiner will furnish all services and personnel necessary for Medical Examiner operations within Pinellas County. This agreement for professional services includes funding for the laboratory information management system, JusticeTrax (Phase II), and one (1) FTE with equipment for advanced testing of THC.

Medical Examiner operations comprises roughly 60% of the agreement budget and Forensic Laboratory operations including the Chemistry/Fire/Debris Section, the DUI Section, and the DNA Section at roughly 40% of the budget. Under Section 406.06(3) and 406.08(1), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners is responsible for the payment of Medical Examiner fees, salaries, and expenses. In 2018, the Medical Examiner accepted 1,456 Pinellas

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County death cases for examination. There were 701 crime scene investigations in 2017 and 766 crime scene investigations in 2018, an increase of 9.0%.
