Limits set are the minimums set in the ALS agreement 17-1236A. Copy of CR form is attached. **New agreement includes wording requiring minimum limit from ALS agreement.**

NOTES: The Growth Management Plan is designed to ensure ALS First Responder Units are available for rapid response time life-threatening medical emergencies, potentially life-threatening emergencies and available for fire suppression and other hazardous emergencies, through the response of Ambulances only to non-life-threatening and routine patient transportation requests for service.

The plan also contains provisions for other growth management initiatives to reduce the demand for EMS services through public education, community outreach, pathway management and alternate response configurations for segments of patients not experiencing life-threatening or potentially life-threatening emergencies.
