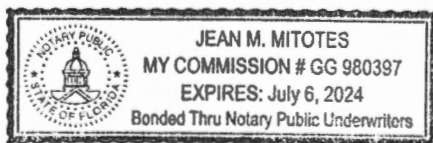

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners proposes to increase the Retail Water, Wholesale Water, Retail Sewer, Wholesale
Sewer, Retail Reclaimed Water, and Wholesale Reclaimed Water rates by Resolution.
A public hearing on the Resolution will be held on Tuesday, June 13, 2023, at 9:30 A.M. in the County Commission Assembly Room,
Fifth Floor, Pinellas County Courthouse, 315 Court Street, Clearwater, Florida 34616.
The public hearing will be streamed live at https://youtube.com/pccv1 and www.pinellascounty.org/TV and broadcast on the Pinellas
County cable public access channels:

Members of the public wishing to address the body may attend in person, attend virtually, or provide comments in advance.

To address the County Commission in person, members of the public are encouraged to pre-register at pinellas.com/comments.
Pre-registration is encouraged but not required if individuals plan to attend the meeting at the Assembly Room. Those who have not
pre-registered may register when they arrive.

Members of the public wishing to address the body virtually via Zoom or by phone are required to pre-register by 5:00 P.M. the
