

RESOLUTION 98- 216

WHEREAS, 98-34, Laws of Florida (1998), amended various Florida Statutes relating to public officers' bonds, and

WHEREAS, the County Risk Manager has reviewed the various statutory requirements in conjunction with the County Attorney's Office, as well as the risk associated with each of the offices and the insurance coverages in place, and

WHEREAS, the Board had previously adopted Resolution 96-287, setting these bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners sets the amounts of the bonds as follows:
