

RESOLUTION NO. 26 - ____

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AN INCREASED FEE FOR DISPOSAL OF APPROVED SOLID WASTE AT THE SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, Pinellas County Solid Waste Disposal Facilities operates on a user fee basis; and

WHEREAS, Pinellas County Code § 106-53 requires fees be fixed and established by resolution of the Board after public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the code also requires the Technical Management Committee (TMC) make recommendations to the Board concerning, among other things, fees; and

WHEREAS, a rate study was prepared by Raftelis Financial Consultants Inc., and the TMC had the benefit of the rate study; and

WHEREAS, the TMC, at a publicly noticed meeting on January 20, 2026 reviewed and recommended a fee of \$63.57 per ton for one (1) year, with additional increases recommend in subsequent years as provided in the rate study; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Pinellas County Code § 106-53 this resolution is adopted following advertised public hearings; and

WHEREAS, all other Solid Waste fees remain unchanged.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners, duly assembled on this ____ day of _____ 2026, as follows:

The fee for Approved Solid Waste be increased from the current rate of \$58.86 per ton to:

1. \$63.57 per ton effective October 1, 2026
2. \$68.65 per ton effective October 1, 2027
