A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA; VACATING THE 16 FOOT WIDE ALLEY LYING EASTERLY OF LOT 7, BLOCK 9 AND WESTERLY OF LOTS 5, 6, AND A PORTION OF LOT 4, BLOCK 9, ANN PARK HEIGHTS, PLAT BOOK 6, PAGE 100, LYING IN SECTION 3-31-16, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** Wat Lao Mixayaram, Inc., (the Petitioner) has petitioned this Board of County Commissioners to vacate the following described property:

Lands described in the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference made a part hereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Petitioner has shown that the vacation of such portions of the plat will not affect the ownership or right of convenient access of persons owning other parts of the subdivision; and

**WHEREAS,** the Petitioner's affidavit has been received by the Board of County Commissioners.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida that the above described property and plat be vacated, insofar as this Board of County Commissioners has the authority to do so, pursuant to §336.09, Florida Statutes, subject however, to the following:

1. Petitioner must bring the property into compliance with the Pinellas County Code within twelve (12) months of passage of this Resolution, which excludes remediation of the current encroachment into the subject property for which this vacation is sought in part to remedy. Compliance shall be verified in writing by the Director of the Pinellas County Building & Development Review Services Department (BDRS).

2. Any new easement necessitated by virtue of this vacation and subsequent site plan approval

process shall be mutually agreed upon by the Petitioner and the County, which may be

agreed and accepted on behalf of the County by the County Administrator or the

Administrator's designee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board of County

Commissioners shall adopt this Resolution with authorization for the Clerk to record in the Public

Records of Pinellas County, Florida.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption but the

vacation shall not take effect until completion of all terms and conditions contained herein, which

in no event shall exceed twelve (12) months from the date of adoption of this Resolution. If the

conditions are not satisfied within this designated timeframe, the above-referenced property will

not be vacated, and this Resolution will become null and void.
