Age Friendly Community – Why?

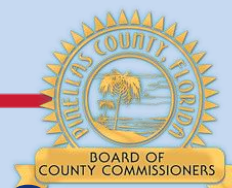
- AARP surveys indicate older adults want to remain in their homes & communities

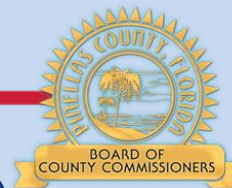
The 8 Domains of Livability

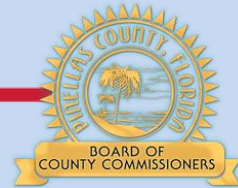
