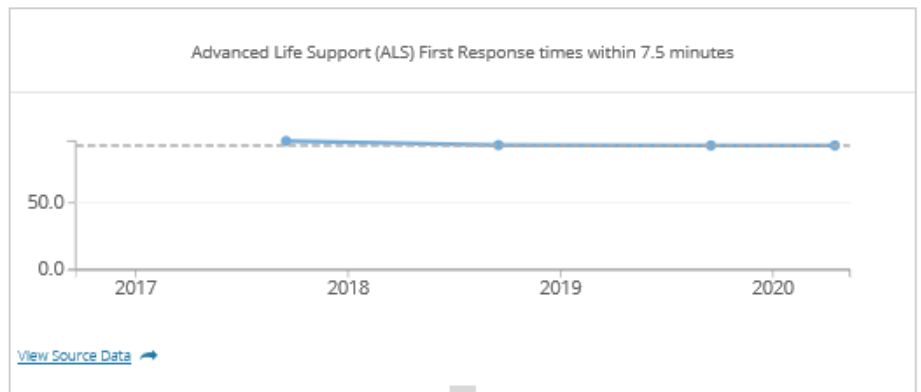
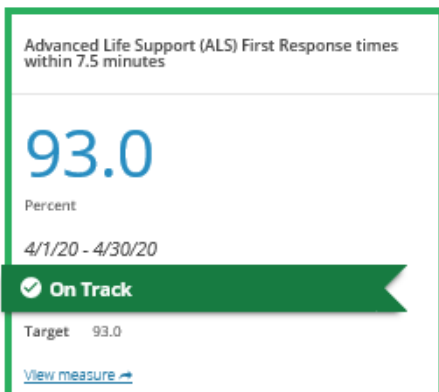
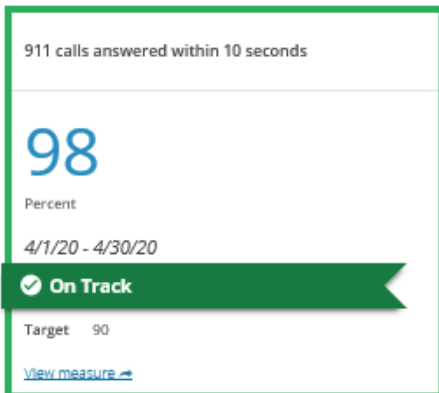


Safety and Emergency Services

Purpose

Safety and Emergency Services (SES) ensures effective and efficient public safety services for residents and visitors within Pinellas County. The department oversees areas of fire protection, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), Regional 911, radios and data communication, and financial services, including ambulance billing. The department manages these functions through four major divisions: Ambulance Billing and Financial Services (ABFS), Fire & EMS Administration, Radio & Technology, and Regional 911. Safety and Emergency Services works closely with public safety agencies to ensure successful collaboration throughout the county.

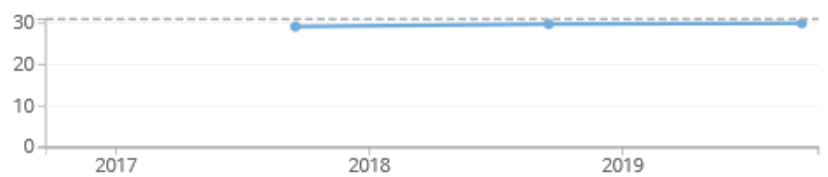

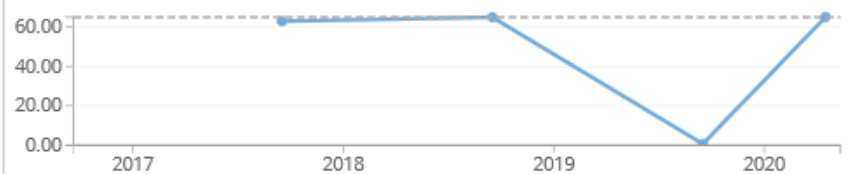

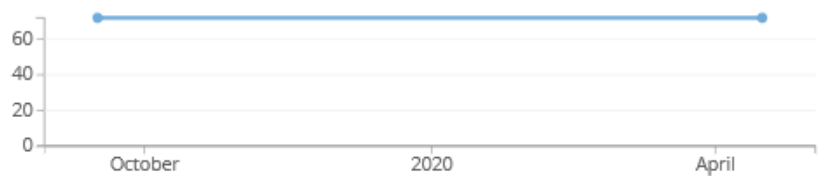
