Human Services is requesting approval of funding recommendations by the Social Action Funding Advisory Board (SAFAB) for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 Social Action Grant Funding Agreements with twenty community agencies, and delegation of authority to the County Administrator to sign all associated agreements and documentation.

- Pinellas County Human Services administered a competitive, online grant application process for the FY25 Social Action Grant.
- The grant solicitation opened on March 11, 2024, and fifty-five applications were received totaling \$5,241,589.32 in requested funding.
- On May 20, 2024, following review and ranking of the applications, the SAFAB voted to recommend awards to twenty (20) projects and three (3) alternates. Awards range from \$32,000.00 to \$150,000.00.
- An amount not to exceed \$1,705,610.00 in funding is allocated in the Human Services FY25 anticipated budget.
