BTS is requesting approval to amend a contract for Cyber Security Response with Mullen Coughlin, LLC.

- The First Amendment increases the self-insured retention amount from \$250,000 to \$500,000 and updates the hourly rates for legal personnel.
- There is no retainer for Cyber Coach and my understanding is there are no costs associated with this unless there is an incident. If there is an incident, Pinellas County has an out-of-pocket cost of \$500,000. All eligible items beyond \$500,000 are reimbursable by insurance policies.
 - Example I: An event costs the County \$300,000. The County pays \$300,000 outof-pocket and does not cross the \$500,000 threshold. No funds are reimbursable, and the County will have to pay all \$300,000.
 - Example II: An event costs the County \$1,000,000. The County pays \$500,000 out-of-pocket and everything eligible beyond \$500,000 is reimbursable by insurance coverage. County pays only \$500,000 out of pocket.
- Funding for this contract is budgeted in FY25 in the Risk Financing Fund in the Department of Administrative Services.
