This resolution will repeal Resolution No. 05-59, adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on April 5, 2005, establishing the Municipal Recycling Grant Program. The program reimbursed municipalities for expenditures directly related to and supporting recycling. The program has fulfilled its purpose, and alternative uses of these funds will better support waste diversion in the future.

Funding for this grant program is included in the current-year budget of the Solid Waste Department in the Solid Waste Revenue and Operating Fund in the amount of \$500,000.00.

Repeal of the MRG Program will make these funds available for alternate waste diversion programs, such as a safety ad campaign for the disposal of rechargeable batteries in the amount of \$93,000. The repeal of the MRG program will reduce the Solid Waste Department's FY27 Operating Budget by \$407,000.00.
