OPUS Project Title: Philippe Park Shoreline

Proposed Abstract (Project Scope of Work): The County is implementing a living shoreline project at the Philippe Park to increase resiliency to storm surge/sea level rise, to create habitat for wildlife, and to provide demonstration/education about coastal resiliency. Part of the project is a series of oyster reef wave attenuation barriers (WABs) to reduce erosion and create habitat. Full design for these WABs is complete, but funding has not yet been secured for installation. The WABs will consist of oyster reef balls and rip-rap which should quickly recruit oysters. The park receives many visitors, so it is ideal for outreach.

Benefit Summary (How will this benefit the County, Dept, etc?): The installation of WABs will reduce erosion and increase resiliency along 1,335 linear feet of shoreline, increase seagrass recruitment landward of the WABs, and provide hard substrate for oyster community expansion. Water clarity will be improved due to reduced wave action, decreased erosion, and filtering by oysters. Educational signage will be installed describing the WABs and benefits of living shorelines in addressing sea level rise and storm surge.

Funds from this grant will allow installation of the already designed WABs. Match will be from TBERF (\$93,000 already secured) and from Parks CIP (\$82,000 already in budget).
