If the regional consortium's Phase 1 application is accepted by the EDA, Pinellas County will then be obligated to share in the local match amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 (County Local Match).

The match amount <u>is not</u> included in the preliminary FY24 budget submission from the department. If selected, the match could be anywhere from \$10,000-\$100,000, depending on the contributions from the partners. The notifications for application acceptance are expected to come out in October FY24. If PCED's application is accepted in October, <u>PCED may need a budget amendment</u> to provide the match funding.
