

RESOLUTION 19- 14

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AN INCREASED FEE FOR DISPOSAL OF APPROVED SOLID WASTE AT THE SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Pinellas County Utilities Solid Waste Disposal Facilities operate on a user fee basis; and

WHEREAS, Pinellas County Code § 106-53 requires that fees be fixed and established by resolution of the Board after Public Hearing; and

WHEREAS, the code also requires that the Technical Management Committee (TMC) make recommendations to the Board concerning, among other things, fees; and

WHEREAS, a rate study was prepared by Public Resources Management Group, Inc., and the TMC had the benefit of the rate study; and

WHEREAS, the TMC has reviewed and approved the increased fee for Approved Solid Waste; and

WHEREAS, all other fees remain unchanged.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, in regular session duly assembled this 12 day of March, 2019, after taking public comment pursuant to Pinellas County Code § 106-53:

The fee for Approved Solid Waste be increased from the current rate of \$37.50 per ton to:

1. \$39.75 per ton effective October 1, 2019
2. \$42.15 per ton effective October 1, 2020
3. \$44.70 per ton effective October 1, 2021.

Commissioner Eggers offered the foregoing Resolution and moved its adoption, which was seconded by Commissioner Gerard, and upon roll call the vote was:
