A Joint Project Agreement with the City of Madeira Beach for County utility relocations in conjunction with the City roadway and drainage improvements project.

Florida Statutes 337.403 obligates the owner of a utility interfering with the maintenance, improvement, extension, or expansion of a public road to initiate the work alleviate the interference at the utility owner's expense.

Funding for this agreement is budgeted under 129th and 131st Avenue E. Utility Relocation, City of Madeira Beach Project 005073A, included in the FY25-FY30 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), funded by the Water Renewal and Replacement Fund and the Sewer Renewal and Replacement Fund, in the amount of \$1,370,000.00, which is less than the agreement amount. The Proposed FY26-FY31 CIP includes a total project allocation of \$1,940,000.00.

Funding in the Proposed FY26-FY31 CIP is contingent upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners via two public hearings in September 2025.
