



Florida leads the nation in the number of homes—along with property value and tax base (based on current values for each)—at risk of chronic inundation through the end of the century. At the ZIP code level, shown here with symbols located at the center of each ZIP code area, the Miami area, the Florida Keys, and Tampa-St. Petersburg stand out as being the most highly exposed within the next 30 years. By the end of the century, nearly 100 ZIP code areas in Florida could see properties chronically flooded that today represent 40 percent or more of their property tax base.
