### Description & Comments

This is for approval to adopt a Resolution waiving double the permit fee for building permits and construction in a floodplain within the unincorporated County and communities of Belleair Beach, Belleair Shore, Indian Rocks Beach, Oldsmar, Kenneth City, and Safety Harbor, submitted from September 19, 2025 through December 31, 2025, for after-the-fact permits for work already commenced or completed on storm damaged properties directly or indirectly, by Hurricane Helene or Hurricane Milton, subject to specific conditions.

Funding for this resolution is not included in the current-year budget of Building and Development Review Services in the Building Services Fund. The full permit fee will be collected and any *additional* revenue (the department estimates approximately \$1.9M) that would have been collected associated with “double the permit fee” was not a budgeted amount as it is specific to only storm-impacted properties.
