Summary:

In 2016, former Health and Human Services Division Director Natalie Jackson-Fuller filed an eight count federal complaint against the County. The County Attorney's Office obtained the dismissal of all but the claims of racial discrimination and Workers' Compensation retaliation. Trial is set for May 1, 2018, and the County is awaiting ruling on its motion for summary judgment. The Plaintiff has made a settlement demand of \$89,000.00 to resolve the federal claims.

It is recommended that settlement be rejected. Outside counsel is optimistic about the County's likelihood of success on summary judgment.

Background Information:

The County previously offered \$50,000.00 to settle both the federal lawsuit and the underlying Workers' Compensation case. That offer was rejected and the Workers' Compensation claim was eventually settled for \$20,000.00.
