

**Housing Finance Authority – TEFRA Hearing
Pinellas County
April 9, 2026**

The Housing Finance Authority of Pinellas County (HFA) (as created by the Code of Ordinances of Pinellas County, Section 2-386) met in special session to conduct a public hearing at 9:00 AM on this date at the HFA's office located at 450 Carillon Parkway, Suite 105, St. Petersburg, Florida 33716.

PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED ISSUANCE BY THE HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY OF PINELLAS COUNTY OF ITS MULTIFAMILY HOUSING REVENUE BONDS (SKYE ISLE), SERIES [TO BE DETERMINED] IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$27,000,000 IN ONE OR MORE INSTALLMENTS OR SERIES.

Pursuant to notice published on the HFA's website on March 26, 2026, as evidenced by affidavit of publication, a public hearing was, held for the purpose of receiving comments and hearing discussion concerning the proposed issuance by the Authority of its Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds (Skye Isle Apartments), Series [to be determined], in an aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$27,000,000 in one or more installments or series pursuant to a plan of finance, over a period of time exceeding one year, but not longer than permitted by such Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Ms. Driver indicated that the proceeds of the Bonds will be used to finance (i) the acquisition, rehabilitation and equipping of a 188 unit multifamily rental housing facility for persons or families of moderate, middle or lesser income within the City of St. Petersburg, Pinellas County, to be known as Skye Isle, formerly known as the Viridian, located at 518 3rd Avenue South, St. Petersburg, FL 33701, which will initially be owned and operated by Preservation 518, Ltd., a Florida limited partnership, or one of its affiliates.

No one appeared in response to Ms. Driver's call for persons wishing to be heard in favor of or in opposition to the proposed bond issuance; whereupon, she closed the public hearing.
