The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners proposes to amend the Pinellas County Code by Ordinance.

A public hearing on the Ordinance will be held on Tuesday, January 26, 2021, at 8:00 P.M., in the Parks and Conservation Resources – Magnolia Room, 12520 Ulmerton Road, Largo, Florida 33774. This is a hybrid Board of County Commissioners regular meeting with both in-person and virtual participation utilizing Communications Media Technology (CMT) on the ZOOM platform.

Members of the public wishing to address the body may attend in person, attend virtually or provide comments in advance. Space for in-person attendance is very limited due to COVID-19 social distancing. Members of the public are strongly encouraged to participate virtually or to provide comments in advance.

To address the County Commission in person, members of the public are encouraged to preregister at <u>PlinelasCountv.org/comment</u>. Preregistration is encouraged but not required if individuals plan to attend the meeting at the Magnolia Room. Those who have not preregistered may register when they arrive.
