OMB has no objection to the Public Works Department submitting a grant application to the Federal Highway Administration's 2022 Bridge Investment Program.

This is a multi-year reimbursement grant project that will likely impact FY23 – FY25. The requested funding is \$5,490,000.00 and has a match requirement. The match amount is \$610,000.00 and the total estimated project cost is \$90,000,000.00. This grant funding will impact capital project 000423A Dunedin Causeway Bridge Project, which is currently reflected in the proposed budget as Penny funded.
