The Pinellas County Office of Human Rights administers [Chapter 70 of the Pinellas County Code of Ordinances](#), which prohibits discrimination in employment and Title VI (LEP) because of race, color, religion, sex (including pregnancy discrimination and sexual harassment), sexual orientation, national origin, age, marital status or disability. This law, which applies to all employers located in Pinellas County with five or more employees, labor organizations, and public and private employment agencies, covers all conditions and terms of employment including recruitment, selection, promotion, transfer, pay, tenure, discipline, discharge, and privileges.
