**Description & Comments**

The Human Services Department requests approval of the of the agreement with Jon R. Thogmartin, M.D., P.A., District Six Medical Examiner (Medical Examiner) for professional services related to the Medical Examiner's Office and Pinellas County Forensic Laboratory.

The ME Contract for FY22 is increasing by \$522,010, or 8.34% over the FY21 contract amount. This change is a result of increased caseloads and payroll related expenditures (inflationary increases), including the addition of two positions new from the prior year.

The County will compensate Dr. Thogmartin at a rate of \$260,706.15/biweekly. The first three (3) payments will be paid as one lump sum (\$782,118.45) as the first payment. Funding in the amount of \$6,778,360 has been included in the FY22 Proposed Budget for this purpose.

In addition, the Medical Examiner's Office shall pay the County 20.0% of all DUI-related services rendered to Pasco County or Pinellas County law enforcement which shall be paid monthly to the County.
