This item adopts an ordinance which amends Section 118-32 of Pinellas County Code relating the Tourist Development Plan (TDP). The amended section would add 'publicly owned and operated beach park facilities that are directly associated with or demonstrated to be tourist attractions' to allowable uses of Tourist Development Tax funds in the Pinellas County Tourist Development Plan.

The adoption of this ordinance has no fiscal impact on Pinellas County. However, the amended TDP would allow additional potential projects to be eligible for TDT funding within the Capital Projects Funding Program.
