Human Services is requesting Approval and execution by the County Administrator of the Assignment of the City of Belleair Bluff's City/County Funds, from the opioid litigation settlement to the Pinellas County's City/County Fund.

- The State of Florida entered into settlement agreements pursuant to the opioid litigation and created the City/County Fund to distribute funds both to municipalities and counties.
- Belleair Bluffs seeks to assign its opioid funds to the County for distribution to support approved purposes and administrative oversight.
- The County currently provides and will expand its provision of opioid abatement services on a county-wide basis serving both incorporated and unincorporated areas, including Belleair Bluffs.
- Belleair Bluff's anticipated allocation of the settlement is \$31,705.26. Belleair Bluffs has not received payment and has not filed any reporting with the State.
- There is no direct cost or expense associated with entering into this assignment. Pinellas County is eligible to receive a 5% administrative fee for supporting the administration and oversight of the Belleair Bluffs allocation as we do with the other city assignments. No budget amendment will be necessary to add these funds to the budget as the Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 budget is sufficient to cover the expected expenditures for FY26.

Fiscal Impact:

Largo's allocation of the settlement is \$31,705.26.
