Date/Time/Comments: 12/19/2018 Approve and execute the Subrecipient Funding Agreement with the Pinellas County School Board (PCSB) for the Pinellas School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP). Agreement is public entity to public entity and does not require application of insurance requirements.

NOTES: Funding from this Agreement will allow PCSB to acquire and install school safety technology in 122 schools by late 2019. The SVPP is part of a two-phase plan to deploy a centralized, automated lockdown system in each Pinellas school, which will provide first responders and law enforcement interactive access to live information during the event of an active shooter or other emergency incident. Phase I is to provide the infrastructure for this system, to include a wired panic button in each of the 122 schools which will automatically lock and access all control systems in the schools. Phase II is to build upon the infrastructure with enhanced cutting-edge technology blended with best practices to meet the challenges of constantly evolving threats.
