

PUBLIC NOTICE OF LIVE PUBLIC HEARING **INCLUDING VIRTUAL PARTICIPATION**

In accordance with the Executive Office of the Governor Orders 20-69, 20-91 20-112, 20-123, 20-139, and 20-150, and Pinellas County Emergency Official Authority Order 20-3, the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners will conduct a public hearing on a proposed Resolution to accept the 15 year review of the Largo West Bay Drive Community Redevelopment Plan, as set forth below:

The Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing with live participation in the Magnolia Room at the Florida Botanical Gardens, 12520 Ulmerton Rd., Largo, FL 33774, as well as virtual participation utilizing Communications Media Technology (CMT) on the Zoom platform, on July 21, 2020 at 6:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as may be accommodated by the completion of the rest of the Board agenda.

As space in the meeting room is limited due to social distancing necessities, the public is encouraged to watch the live stream or participate virtually.

The proposed resolution is entitled:

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE 15 YEAR REVIEW OF THE WEST BAY DRIVE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE CITY OF LARGO PURSUANT TO PINELLAS COUNTY CODE SECTION 38-73 RELATED TO THE CITY OF LARGO COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA; REQUIRING AMENDMENTS FOR INCLUSION INTO THE WEST BAY DRIVE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN PURSUANT TO THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1969, CHAPTER 163, PART III, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This resolution will formally accept the 15 year review for the West Bay Drive Community Redevelopment Plan, and require that the City of Largo amend the plan to include an updated project list. The resolution will also ensure that future Pinellas County contributions to the Tax Increment Trust Fund will not exceed those made by the City of Largo.

In review of the Resolution above, there may be modifications that arise at the public hearings and/or with other responsible parties.
