Amber,

The damage survey reports (DSR's) covering the erosion control for Pinellas County EWP related to Hurricane Milton have been approved. Only funding for MIL-PIN-005 has been received. I am awaiting funding for the others.

The approved DSR's and estimated costs are below:

- MIL-PIN-002 - \$2,201,413
- MIL-PIN-003 - \$5,343,715
- MIL-PIN-004 - \$3,824,736
- MIL-PIN-005 - \$4,478,987
- MIL-PIN-006 - \$7,167,942
- MIL-PIN-007 - \$3,749,211

The total estimated construction cost is \$26,766,004.00. NRCS will reimburse for 100% of the construction cost (not to exceed \$26,766,004.00) and also 10% of the construction cost (not to exceed \$2,676,600.40) for technical services items such as survey, design, contract administration, and inspection.

The Emergency Watershed Protection (EWP) program operates via a cooperative agreement between NRCS and the sponsor, where the sponsor administers the agreement and manages the work. In order to start preparing the agreement, I need the following items completed and returned to me:

- SF-424 (Application for Federal Assistance) – I have entered the correct budget numbers in Section 18 already. Yellow cells are required cells.
- SF-424D
- Certification Regarding Lobbying
- FPAC-GAD-9 (sponsor's points of contact)

Signatures on these documents need to be either a hand signature that is scanned or an electronic signature with an appropriate certificate.

I have also attached these same forms used for the first agreement for your reference. As of now, I am just calling this new agreement #2.

As a sponsor, you need to be registered with sam.gov and have a unique entity identifier (UEI).
