### Description & Comments

Human Services is requesting approval of the Agreement with Ignyte Group, Inc. for the development, implementation, and support of the Mental and Behavioral health Coordinated Access Model (CAM) platform utilizing the County's existing Appian environment.

- This Agreement provides for the design, configuration, implementation, and support of a Coordinated Access Model (CAM) technology platform to improve access to mental and behavioral health services across Pinellas County.
- The not-to-exceed amount of \$1,321,819.93 includes a 10% contingency set aside to be used if additional needs arise during project development.
- Funding for the contract will be entirely from City/County Opioid Abatement settlement funds. These funds are accounted for in their own special revenue fund, separate from the general fund.
- Funding is a one-time investment for implementation costs only. Annual licensing costs for the platform are approximately \$30,000 going forward which is a significant cost reduction from the current vendor.
- Funding for this agreement is included in the FY26 Adopted Budget for Human Services within the Opioid Fund. Funding for future years is dependent on approval in the annual County Operating Budget.

Contract No. 24-0552-RFQ in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1,321,819.93 for a period of approximately eight (8) months; Authorize the Chairman to sign and the Clerk of the Circuit Court to attest.
