#### Review & Comments

This OMB Grants Team has conducted a review of the **Human Services** intent to apply for the **FY25 STOP School Violence Program** funded by **Bureau of Justice Assistance**.

#### Project Scope of Work

The goal of the STOP School Violence Program is to improve school safety by providing students and teachers with the tools they need to recognize, quickly respond to, and help prevent acts of violence. Pinellas County Human Services will partner with Pinellas County Schools to expand school safety and violence prevention initiatives, to include training school personnel and educating students on preventing student violence against others and themselves. This may also include anti-bullying and/or specialized training for school officials and law enforcement to respond to mental health crises.

#### Anticipated Impact to the County Budget

This is a **Multi Year** grant potentially affecting **FY26, FY27, & FY28**. The application request is for \$1,000,000.00 with no cost share requirement. The total project budget is \$1,000,000.00.
