

Homelessness in Pinellas County


- For every 10,000 people living in Pinellas County in 2010, there were 43 people living unhoused
 - In 2020, there are 22.8
- Statewide there are 18





Sheltered vs. Unsheltered


- ▶ In Pinellas, the sheltered count is down 24%
 - Down 10% nationwide
- ▶ In Pinellas, the unsheltered count is down 60%
 - Down 12% nationwide



Chronic Homelessness

- ▶ Over the past ten years, the number of chronically homeless individuals in Pinellas increased by 25%
- ▶ In the US, chronic homelessness is up 4%
- ▶ **Good News!** In the last 2 years, this number has decreased by 20%

Housing Rates

- ▶ From 2010-2020, we housed 16,302 people with a 33.70% success rate
- ▶ In 2019, we housed 1,995 people with a 33.48% success rate
- ▶ In 2020, we housed 1,396 people with a 23.47% success rate





Where Are We Now? 2019-2020

- ▶ **Total homelessness is down 8%**
- ▶ Unsheltered is down 3% and sheltered is down 10%
- ▶ Chronic homelessness is down 20%
- ▶ Veteran homelessness down 16%
