Human Services is requesting the approval and execution by the County Administrator of the amendment to the agreement with the Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) for the 2023 Criminal Justice, Mental Health, and Substance Abuse (CJMHA) Reinvestment Grant.

- The CJMHA Reinvestment Grant funds implementation or expansion projects that increase public safety and avert increased spending on criminal and juvenile justice systems.
- The County’s Treatment for Individuals Experiencing Homelessness (TIEH) project serves adults 18 or over who have a mental illness, substance use disorder, or co-occurring disorder and who are in, or at risk of entering the criminal justice system.
- The award provides \$400,000.00 per year over three years for a total of \$1,200,000.00. A 100% in-kind match is provided by Pinellas County Human Services, Boley Centers, Inc., Pinellas County Sheriff’s Office, and Eleos.
- The amendment corrects language in the original DCF agreement, Exhibit C-Task List Section C.2.4.3, and Exhibit E- Minimum Performance Measure’s and Performance Evaluation Methodology, sections E.1.1 through E.2.6.
- There is no fiscal impact by or through this item.
