(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.) Housing and Community Development is seeking Approval of project recommendations for Emergency Solutions Grants Program-Rapid Unsheltered Survivor Housing (ESG-RUSH) funding and authorize the County Administrator to sign agreements. The County issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for \$512,336.00 of ESG-RUSH funding on February 10, 2025, receiving four (4) applications totaling \$700,635.00 in funding requests. Funding awards are recommended for two (2) projects, Metropolitan Ministries Family Shelter Operations and St. Vincent de Paul CARES - Care Center Operations totaling \$216,724.00 in funding awards. A second NOFA identifying the availability of remaining ESG-RUSH funds and the annual ESG entitlement funding for Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-housing activities will be issued. On February 11, 2025, the Board approved a Substantial Amendment to the 2024-2025 Annual Action Plan which included the application for ESG-RUSH funds.

ESG-RUSH funding is not included in the Fiscal Year 2025 (FY25) Operating Budget for HCD in the Community Development Grant Fund and will generate unanticipated revenue when received. A budget amendment to recognize this new grant funding of \$512,366 will be proposed for approval.
