<p>The BioWatch Program has been on-going in Pinellas County since 2003. This award modification changes the project & budget period end date from 9/30/18 to 6/30/18. On 8/17/17, the County received modification 1 to the FY18 award (File 17-802D), approving the carryover funds from FY17 (\$111,500) to be used for FY18 expenses, but de-obligating the FY18 funding previously awarded. The remaining available funding out of that amount (\$66,727 as of 1-30-18) is expected to be depleted by 6/30/18. DHS will notify the County if additional funding becomes available in FY18, and a new application will be submitted at that time. There is no additional fiscal impact with this modification, only the end date is being modified.</p>
