Project Scope of Work

Design and Pre-Construction Activities for Airport Passenger Terminal Improvements to include A/E Design Services, CMAR Pre-Construction Design Services, Owner's Representative Pre-Construction Design Services

Benefit Summary

PIE has experienced 142% growth in 11 years and the current terminal facility is having issues meeting that growth. We need more passenger seating, more security lines, more concession space and expansion of gates, along with more jet bridges to keep passengers from having to board aircraft in bad weather. This project will be very important in keeping our passenger experience positive and in line with possible air carrier growth.

Anticipated Impact to the County Budget

This is a **Multi-Year** grant potentially affecting **FY25**, **FY26**, **FY27**, **and FY28**. This application request is for \$4,914,957.00 with a \$1,228,739.00 cost share required. The total project budget is \$200,000,000.00.
