To the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners,

My name is Annetta Speicher and I live in Baywood Village, a Palm Harbor, FL community.

I am here today with other Baywood Village residents, concerning dangerous, hazardous waste, debris, and abandoned equipment from the Crosswinds Bridge Project that has been assigned CATS (County Assignment Tracking System) 55119.

Baywood Village residents have been held captive for 3 years now by an unscrupulous contractor who is currently in default on their Pinellas County, Florida construction contracts, leaving people with dangerous rubble and debris in their yards and a Triangle/Staging Area that contains flammable hazardous waste and an unsanitary, smelly (unserviced) portable toilet, construction equipment, etc.

We are aware that our concerns regarding this dangerous rubble and debris have now been escalated up within agencies of Pinellas County and believe that CATS 55119 was opened due to our collective concerns being raised. Prior to this, we believe the County was primarily focused on dealings with the defaulting contractor. Therefore, we as a community are compelled to increase our visibility and get on the public record in order to clean up our neighborhood, reclaim our properties, and seek reparations where they are due.

Many who were unable to attend in person today requested to sign a petition in support of the message that is being delivered. It states:

PETITION REQUESTING THAT PINELLAS COUNTY TAKE IMMEDIATE ACTION TO CLEAN UP CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS AND DEBRIS FROM CROSSWINDS BRIDGE PROJECT IN BAYWOOD VILLAGE, PALM HARBOR, FL

"We, the undersigned residents of Baywood Village in Palm Harbor, Florida wish to have our voices heard in the January 16, 2024 Board meeting regarding the abandoned Crosswinds Bridge Project /aka/ County Assignment Tracking System (CATS) 55119.

- 1) Provide equipment and workforce for the immediate cleanup and removal of debris that does not belong to the contractor in question (AEB /aka/ American Empire Builders).
 - We believe this includes but is not limited to the porta potty, broken up piles of pavement and dirt, discarded trash (including live shotgun shells, broken pallets, a dilapidated cooler with the lid broken off, etc.).
- 2) Identification and relocation of property that belongs to the contractor. We understand that this may be complicated but believe that some kind of arrangement must be made. (We believe that the contractor continues to use our properties /aka/ the "Debris Field" for purposes unrelated to the abandoned Crosswinds Bridge project and does not want to lose their access to this location.)
 - O We believe this includes but is not limited to a potentially environmentally toxic Off-Road Diesel Fuel tank, a dilapidated box car, traffic barrels, etc. The list may be longer but we as residents cannot accurately determine what belongs to whom without assistance from the County."

The petition has more than 200 original signatures from Baywood Village residents that are being submitted to the Board this morning.

Additionally, we have submitted photo packets to each of you. We understand that you have already received digital copies of many of these photos through CATS 55119. However, If you would please open your photo packet, I would like to speak to some of the photos.

This first photo is an aerial map view in Baywood Village that points out the Crosswinds Bridge, the Triangle/Staging Area, and what we are calling the "Debris Field". The first thing that caught my attention about this photo was how small the Crosswinds Bridge is in comparison to the Triangle/Staging Area, and even more so to the size of the "Debris Field". I've begun to hear stories from Baywood Village residents that live amongst the "Debris Field" about *the impacts to their properties* (some have had their landscapes and irrigation systems completely destroyed), *the impacts to their social activities* (due to the stench and traffic/navigation/parking issues), *the impacts to their mental well-being* (due to the stench, destruction of property, and noise — all over a 3-year period that was supposed to last 18-months), *and the impacts to their socio-economic well-being* (some properties have been placed on the market because the owners just wanted/needed to escape the burden).

• Case in point: Last Tuesday, January 9th, a severe storm came through and I began getting notifications that the porta potty had been blown over by gusting winds. Please view photos #2, #3, and #4. You will see where a truck came and set the porta potty back upright. Then they left. They didn't secure it. They didn't remove it. Neighborhood members had no choice but to do the responsible thing and go out in the storm to strap it down. By the way, fluid, which we assume was raw sewage, had spilled out of the porta potty onto the ground. Ladies and Gentlemen, if members of the community have to babysit the construction debris and potentially hazardous waste, doesn't that constitute it as a public nuisance? Is that not a liability to the County and/or the Contractor?

Residents' personal landscape and irrigation systems have been completely destroyed by the equipment on their property; Claude, an AEB Foreman, promised that these things would be replaced once the project was completed. Photo's #5 - #18 show conditions on one of the properties closest to the bridge. Some of the photos are zoomed-in shots to emphasize the totality of disrespect these people have received...the invasion of their property for 3 years has not simply been construction equipment and noise. It has included dumped asphalt, discarded debris, and general garbage that should have been properly hauled off, but instead has been thrown down and left. This resident also stated that a portapotty was placed on their property for many months, that the stench was unbearable, that AEB and the County were unresponsive to their complaints, and the Baywood Village Association just recommended that they personally contact the porta-potty company and get it serviced. I mean, how much, really, of this public nuisance should people be expected to tolerate?

Residents are concerned that our streets and curbs are broken down from the construction workers' personal vehicles and contractors' heavy equipment and cranes that have driven over and parked on them. A few years back Baywood Village had a beautification partnership with Pinellas County and our area was parklike. Prior to the now abandoned Crosswinds Bridge Project, Baywood Village's triangle used to include Florida hardy plants, ground cover, a paver walkway and park benches. It was very pretty. (In photos #26 & #32 you can see remnants of the paver walkway and park benches.) You see, we are a community that used to have great pride in ownership of Baywood Village. Now, in direct correlation

with fallout from the Crosswinds Bridge Project, many have let their yards go. I mean, why continue to fight it when your neighborhood is indefinitely and uncontrollably overrun with rubble and debris?

One thing that has not happened as a result of the Crosswinds Bridge Project is any reparation in the form of property tax relief. In fact, our collective taxes have increased steadily over the last 3 years. And for what? An incomplete (and possibly structurally compromised) 55 ft long bridge that is 18" taller than it used to be...destroyed neighborhood streets...wrecked yards...and residents with fried nerves? By the way, the Crosswinds Bridge is the ONLY inlet/outlet to/from homes for hundreds of Baywood Village residents who have no choice but to endure the pillage on a daily basis.

In conclusion, Baywood Village residents are seeking resolution from Pinellas County on <u>at least</u> four separate issues.

- 1) Completion of the Crosswinds Bridge Project.
 - a. The update from last Friday is that the County just approved a 10-day extension for AEB to show measurable progress on the Crosswinds Bridge project before the County determines whether to continue or terminate the contract. AEB has already turned an 18-month project into a 3-year catastrophe. How many more opportunities or extensions are they going to get? Every extension they receive, every accommodation they get, has a direct negative impact to these residents!
 - b. AEB has not only devastated our neighborhood as previously mentioned some residents believe that they observed the construction crew using salt water out of the canal to mix cement while building the bridge, which if true, would compromise the safety and integrity of the bridge. (A topic for a future discussion on a future date.)
- 2) Immediately taking action to clean up our neighborhood of the dangerous debris and stench!!!
 - a. Agents of the County have understandably expressed concerns over items in the "Debris Field" being thrown away, hauled off, or even disturbed due legal fallout, potentially giving the contractor a reason to sue the County over loss of their property. What about the residents who just want their properties back? What about children who just want to play in their neighborhood? What about the hazardous waste and potentially toxic environmental threat to us?
 - b. We are here to propose solutions. We are here because we are starving for results. Therefore, I am offering to inventory/catalogue and photograph in detail, every inch of the debris, and document every outcome, in order to thwart off or refute any of AEB's potential legal claims.
- **3)** Repairing our roads and curbs. They really should be repaired and re-paved using a reputable resource.
- **4)** Restoring any and all irrigation systems, electric, and landscaping that have been ruined to affected residential properties and the Triangle.

Thank you for your time and attention to these matters. Based on the short-term and long-term asks established here, I anticipate that we will meet again soon to revisit progress and next steps.




