This is an intent to apply for the FY23 Paul Coverdell Forensic Sciences Improvement Act Formula Grant Program through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement. If awarded, this grant will benefit the County by improving the quality and timeliness of forensic science services in Pinellas through the provision of external training to crime lab analysts, upgrading existing software for lab personnel, and to procure an FTIR-ATR instrumentation to increase efficiency and add capacity in the seized drug unit. This grant will be multi-year and multi-departmental, which will likely impact Fiscal Year 2024 and Fiscal Year 2025. Human Services has already coordinated with the Pinellas County Medical Examiner and the Florida Department of Law Enforcement. This grant will be administered by Human Services in close coordination with the Pinellas County Medical Examiner and the Florida Department of Law Enforcement. The total application amount is \$62,335.09 with \$0.00 match required. There are no other funding sources associated with this project, which will complete the total project budget of \$62,335.09. This is budgeted and would not likely require a future budget amendment. Based on the thresholds for delegated approval, this grant application will require Director approval to apply.
