Description & Comments

(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.)

An agreement to the General Engineering Continuing Professional Services Agreement with Ardurra Group, Inc. and CDM Smith, Inc. The amendment is largely driven by the need for additional design services for FDOT US19 Utility Relocations from SR580 to Northside project 001522A, FDOT US19 Utility Relocation from Northside to CR95 (estimated at \$1,000,000.00), and emergency remediation of a soil depression on the embankment of the W.E. Dunn WRF reclaimed water pond associated with Dunn Pond Liner Replacement project 003431A (estimated at \$100,000).

Funding for this contract is budgeted but not specifically identifiable in the FY25-30 Capital Improvement Plan or the FY25 Operating Budget because the contract establishes a not to exceed value, with obligation occurring upon issuance of task order assignments (purchase orders). Funding is determined by the individual task order assignment sourced to the agreement, and actual expenditures are contingent upon work completed. The department may appropriate the full not-to exceed amount or less. Task orders for studies will be funded by the Sewer Revenue and Operating Fund and the Water Revenue and Operating Fund, while task orders for capital project design will be funded by the Sewer Renewal and Replacement Fund and the Water Renewal and Replacement Fund.
