Members of the Board of County Commissioners,

The City of Largo strongly supports the adoption of the Sierra Club's Ready for 100 percent renewable energy campaign by Pinellas County in order to ensure a more sustainable future for our shared communities.

Largo similarly adopted this campaign in July 2018 as part of City Resolution No. 2219, specifically adopting an organizational target of powering the City with 100 percent renewable, zero emission energy sources no later than 2035, with a target of being at least 50 percent renewable, zero emission energy sources by 2030. Additionally, through this Resolution, the City adopted a commitment to support the transition of our community to 100 percent renewable, zero emission energy sources, by 2050.

Since its adoption, the Ready for 100 commitment has helped the City to achieve numerous goals across a number of key areas. First, the cities committed to this goal met to discuss their shared objectives. This group would eventually go on to become the Pinellas Sustainability Directors Network. Numerous other networking and capacity building relationships have been created due to this commitment since that time.

This commitment has also helped the City to align numerous other internal projects to ensure maximum return on investment across functional areas. This includes our commitment to a 100 percent alternative fuel, light-duty fleet, and planning process to support all Largo facilities to install renewable energy by 2035.

Largo has also created standards for new facilities to ensure alignment with Ready for 100, including a commitment to maximizing renewable energy on all future buildings. Currently, Largo has one major solar installation at the LEED Platinum-certified Community Center. Future planned installations over the next several years include:

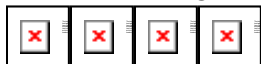
