STATUTE 403.60 IV (H)

H. Special supplementary agreements.—Signatories may enter into special supplementary agreements with the District of Columbia or foreign nations <sup>ISRAEL</sup> for the same purposes and with the same powers as under Paragraph F., Article IV, upon the condition that such nonsignatory party accept the general obligations of signatories under this compact. Provided, that such special supplementary agreements shall become effective only after being consented to by the Congress.

I. Jurisdiction of signatories reserved.—Nothing in this compact or in any supplementary agreement thereunder shall be construed to restrict, relinquish or be in derogation of, any power or authority constitutionally possessed by any signatory within its jurisdiction, except as specifically limited by this compact or a supplementary agreement.
