(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.) Human Services is requesting approval by the County Administrator of the Grant Award for the 2023 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Local (JAG Local).

- The JAG Local provides recurring federal criminal justice funding from the Bureau for Justice Assistance (BJA) for allocation to the City of St. Petersburg (St. Pete) and Pinellas County Sheriff's Office (PCSO).
- PCSO will utilize grant to fund the Raptor Technologies Reunification software and annual access fee for countywide license and includes Raptor technical support. Designed to enhance and streamline the reunification process and offers and integrated platform that facilitates efficient communication and coordination during critical events for law enforcement and first responders.
- St. Pete will use grant funding to sustain several of the department's crime prevention, community policing, and engagement initiatives.
- An MOU with Pinellas County (County), PCSO and St. Pete outlines JAG Local funding allocation.
- The award amount of \$200,925.00 is to be split between PCSO and St. Pete with each receiving \$100,462.50 with PCSO serving as the financial administrator.
- No match is required. This is an annually recurring criminal justice grant supporting PCSO and St. Pete efforts.

Funding in an amount not to exceed \$200,925.00 is provided by the FY 2023 JAG Local grant program. PCSO and St. Pete will each receive \$100,462.50, with PCSO serving as the applicant and fiscal agent for grant administration. This total does not include potential rollover funds. No match is required. The funding is included in the FY24 PCSO Adopted Budget.
